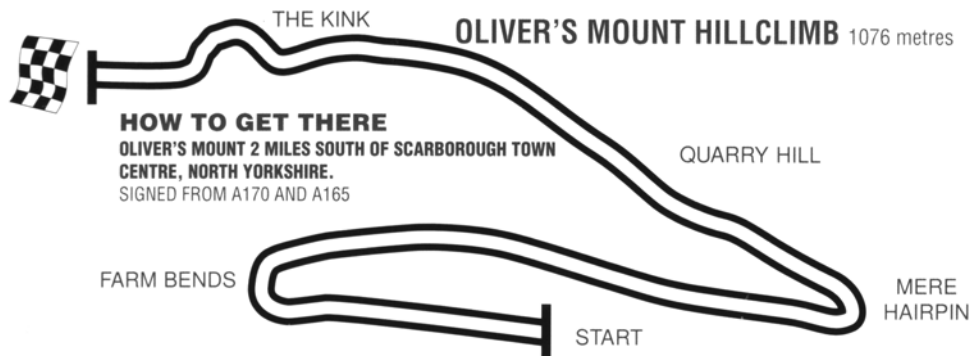
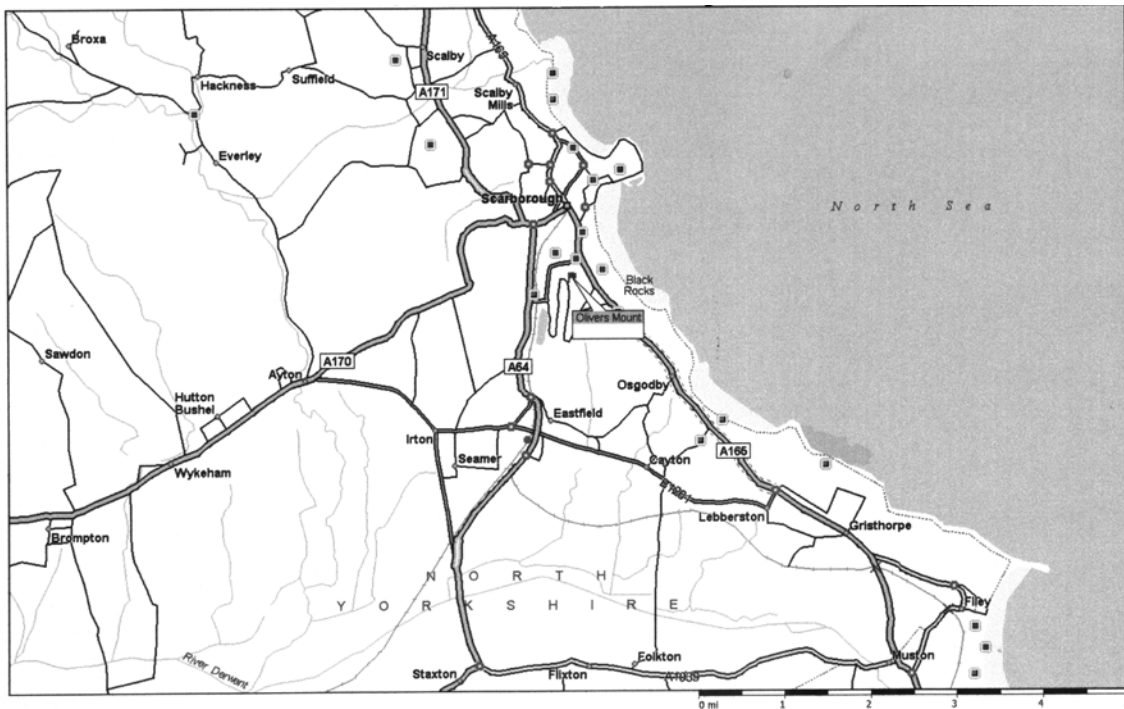


Olivers Mount – Hillclimb – 1.076 Kms

101/039865. 1 mile South of Scarborough, approach off A64 & A165



A slightly uphill start is followed quite quickly by a quite severe right hairpin which falls on to the main straight of the race circuit, up through the gears to maximum speed and keeping over to the right, approach the Mere hairpin. Very hard braking and downshifting required here for this very tight , climbing hairpin then on to the gas, up through the gears to max. speed once again, up Quarry Hill. At the brow of the hill, watch out for the kink, created with cones, keep over to the left, very hard braking, down at least one gear and into a severe right/left/right complex, out with care, (deep drop on the left) , and on to the finish.
