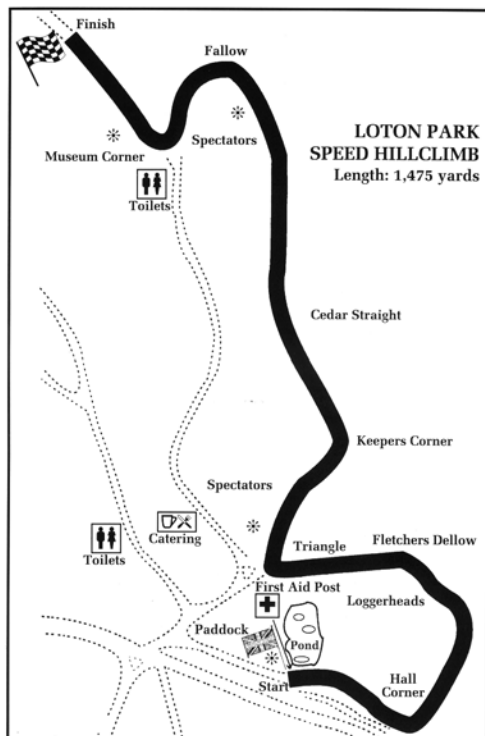
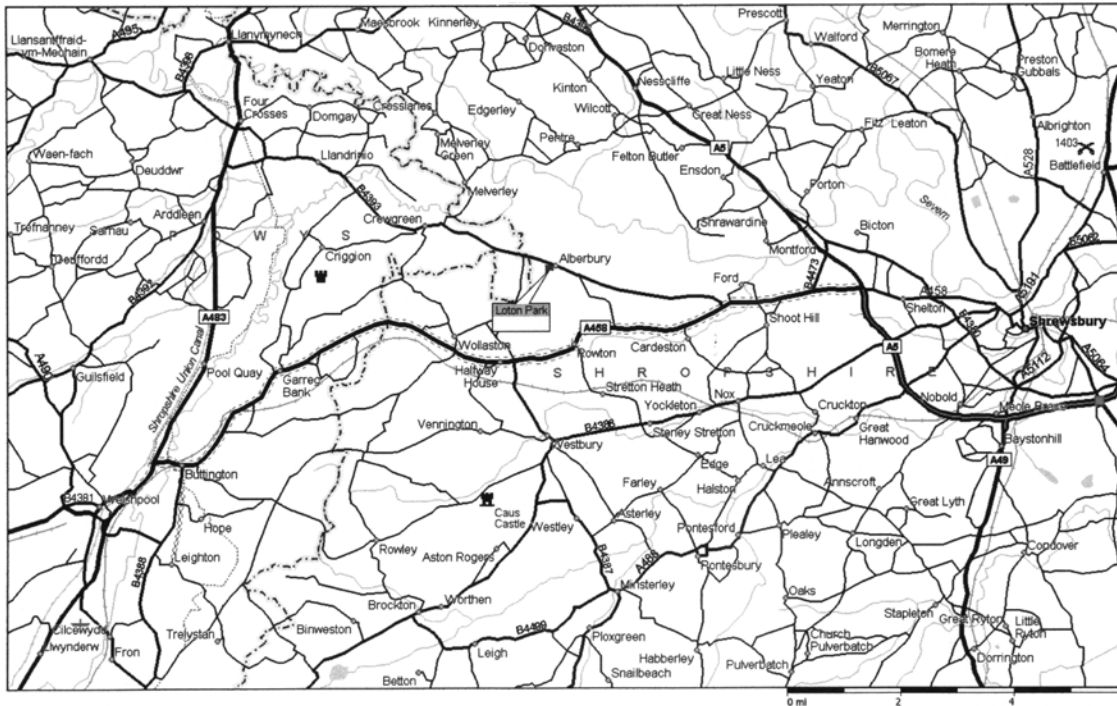


Loton Park – Hillclimb – 1.34 Kms

126/358143. 8.5 miles West of Shrewsbury. Approached by A458 thence B4393 from Shrewsbury.



The start gives reasonable grip and the track immediately goes slightly downhill, turning slightly to the right and heads down to Hall Corner, a 90° left – brake as late as possible and head towards the next bend which is Loggerheads, bends which seem to go on and on, tightening at the end and wriggling through to Fletchers. Accelerate down the short straight leading into Triangle, keeping to the left of the track and braking hard and changing down for the corner. Brush the apex and let the car slide out to the left under acceleration. A dab on the brake will settle the car for the right and left bends at Keepers, (watch out for high rumble strips) and get on the throttle quickly to get a good run up Cedar straight which is actually a series of gentle curves which can be taken flat out. At the top comes Fallow, a very sharp, almost blind left hander before which are braking marker boards which should be noted. After Fallow, keep to the left and brake just before, or on the hump which hides the next and final bend – Museum Corner, a sharp, climbing right hander after which the track drops down to a flat out finishing straight of approx. 10 Mtrs.
