Date: 3rd September 2023

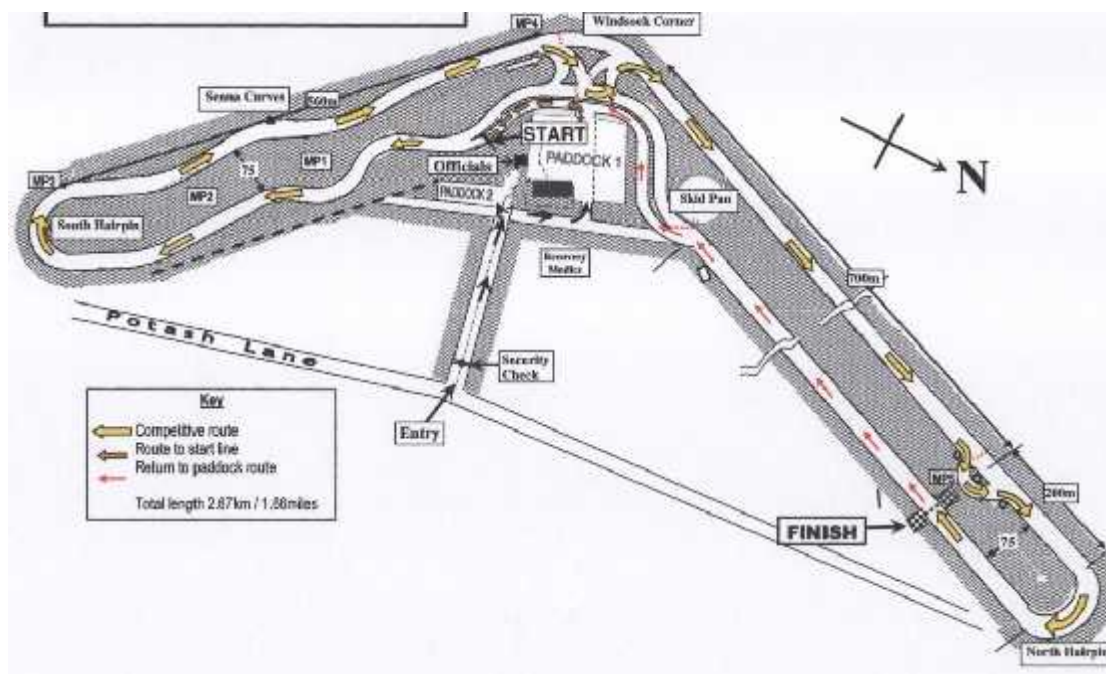
Our second visit this year to the Lotus Test Track near Norwich which has a 1.66 mile course of fast bends and straights with three tight hairpins for good measure. As would be expected the track is laid to a very good standard with lots of grip and has long been a favoured venue.

Although the event was over subscribed, mainly due to it being a part of the Lotus championship, three Morgans managed to get an entry and Nick Bolton and Paul Bryan were joined by former Speedmogger Rob Toon, now competing successfully in the Classic Marques series.

Early morning mist gave way to a fine hot day and with the course being the same as in April a short walk of the twisty sections of the first half before action commenced was enough to refresh our memories.

As we anticipated, after a practice and four competitive runs, the power and torque of Rob's plus 8 made it the quickest Morgan on the day by some three seconds from Nick's lightweight Roadster but Nick should be pleased that he was over two seconds faster than in April whereas I managed two tenths slower.

Once again a very well organised event by the Borough 19 club and a suggestion that a two day event might be possible next year.
